



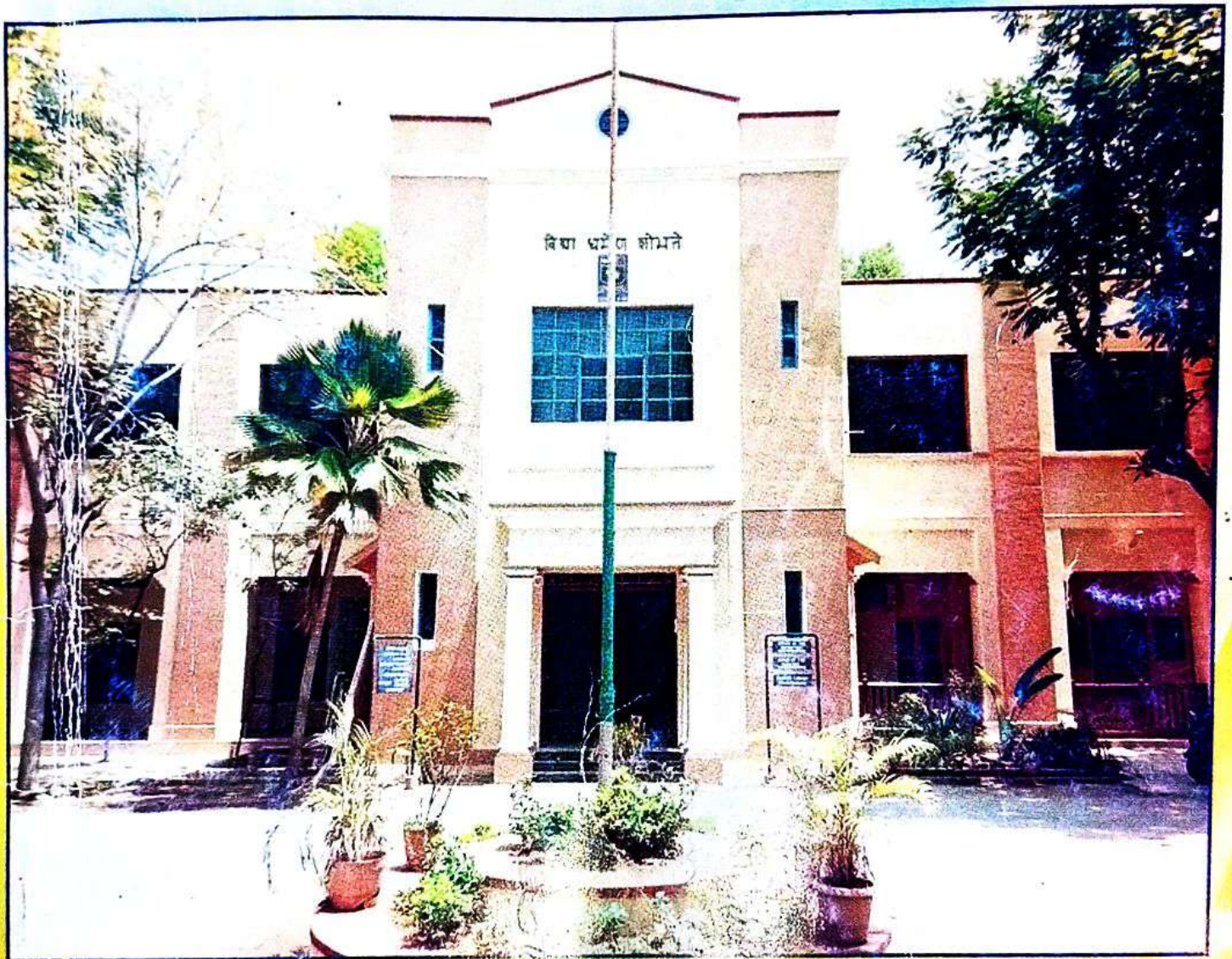

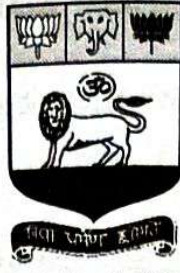

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTION

The Madura College (Autonomous), is an academic institution that stands like a towering titan between centuries. A distinguished institution with a hoary past spanning a century and a quarter, today it shines in the new millennium with the same dynamism and intellectual verve that it has always been known for. The College offers **7 Under-Graduate courses, 9 Post-Graduate programmes and one M.phil programme.** A look into its history reads like a tale of Romance.

The Government had started a Zilla School in 1856 as an outcome of Macaulay's Dispatch of 1854 on Education. In 1880, a College Department was added to it and it was functioning on the premises where the Madura College Higher Secondary School now stands.

An organization called the Madura Native High School Committee was then managing two schools in Madurai, the Native High School in Annakkuzhi Mandapam in West Chitrai Street and a branch of this School in the Velli Ambalam Mandapam in South Chitrai Street. The Government lent the Zilla School building to the Madura Native School Committee in 1888. The Committee saw potentialities in the situation. It offered to take over the Zilla School. In 1889, the School and the College Departments were both taken over by this Committee and renamed itself as the Madura College Committee. The School was then called the Madura Native High School. The Committee went on to acquire another school in the city which had been started by a British Lawyer. In 1903, it also took over the Sethupathi High School and the Town Primary School when their managers found it difficult to run them. Then the Committee got itself registered under the Indian Companies Act of 1882 under the nomenclature "The Madura College Board". The Madura Native High School was renamed as the Madura College

High School and the College, the Madura College. In 1906, a section for girls was opened in the Town Primary School marking an early step in the direction of women's education in this part of the country.

The present premises of the Madura College is about 43 acres in area. Robert S. Fischer made a bequest of five and odd acres to the north of the present campus to be used as playgrounds. Raja Sir. Annamalai Chettiyar donated the rest of the land for this campus.

The Board worked tirelessly to raise funds for putting up buildings for the College and to upgrade it into a first grade institution. It organized fund raising campaigns even conducting a Grand Raffle and selling small portions of its holdings. In 1925, the College became a first grade institution. It was only in 1937 that it could move into the present campus. But the Board could not manage to find funds for endowments and so in 1939, the College became a second grade institution.

Members of the Board and members of the staff of the College worked unrelentingly, going door to door for fund raising, and frequenting the corridors of schools to enlist students. In 1946, the College regained its First Grade Status. About a lakh of rupees was collected for endowment, buildings, prizes and scholarships. The P.M Sankaralyer Hall came up in 1941. The College got the affiliation for B.A. in Mathematics and Economics in 1946-47, for B.Com. in 1947-48, for B.Sc. Physics in 1948-49. for B.Sc. Mathematics in 1949-50 and for B.Sc. Chemistry in 1950-51.

In 1947, the T.V.S Hostel came up with a donation of about a lakh of rupees from the benevolent house of M/S T.V. Sundaram Iyengar and Sons. Pvt. Ltd. Since 2015, the renovated TVS hostel houses the departments of Tamil and English. In 1949, the Harvey Library came up with the help of a donation of a lakh of rupees by the

Madura Mills Co. Ltd. The Gas Room and Setupati Science Block with the help of the Government and the Raja Saheb of Ramnad respectively came up later. The College celebrated its Diamond Jubilee in 1950. The Khajana Babu Rao (KBR) Hostel was the contribution of his family. The KBR hostel was renovated in 2003 to accommodate classrooms and office of the Controller of Examinations. Several other buildings came up subsequently. When the University of Madras finally decided to open a "Replica of the Madras University P.G. Education Centre" at Madurai, the Madura College secured affiliation for post-graduate courses in Mathematics and Physics in 1958 and Chemistry in the next year. In 1959, the Post-Graduate Block of the College came up.

The progress of the College, then on, has been steady. Other courses were introduced in later years. In 1978, the U.G.C. decided to act on its idea of Autonomous Colleges so that useful and responsible experiments could be made for improving quality of higher education qualitatively in the country. Institutions that had a history of academic excellence and committed response to the community's needs were to be selected for the conferment of this status. It was but natural then that the Madura College was accorded this status in the very first group of autonomous Colleges in this university area. The conferment of autonomy was the reward for the hard, visionary work of a band of dedicated workers in the Management and the staff of the College.

In 1983, the Evening College under the self financed stream was started.

When the College was on the threshold of the centenary celebration, a decision was taken by the Madura College Board to suspend undergraduate programmes in arts and replace them with post-graduate

programmes. The College celebrated its centenary in the year 1989.

The College has Centres recognized for research leading to Ph.D. Degree in Zoology (from 1986), Tamil (from 2002), Botany and Philosophy (from 2003), Physics (from 2004) and Economics (from 2011).

A new building for the Biological Sciences and one for the Department of Computer Science came up, thanks to the generous assistance by the UGC. Endowed with excellent infrastructural facilities, the College became co-educational from the academic year 1997-98.

The College has established an exclusive Centre for Computer Training as a common facility and also a Browsing Centre, in a new building. Another building has come up with the Constituency Development Fund made available by Sri P. Mohan, M.P. The first floor on this building was built with the Constituency Development Fund made available by Sri S. CHO Ramasamy, M.P (RajyaSabha)

Another building named as Saroja Krishnamoorthy Block of nearly 2500 sq.ft. came up near the Duraisamy block, thanks to Mr M.Krishnamoorthy, a philanthropist of Madurai.

A 2000 Sq. Ft. "Health Centre" with financial support by UGC X Plan grants has been built in 2006-07. Also a "Sky Watchers" Room has come up under the Autonomous funds for the year 2006-07.

Autonomy review committee visited the college during October 2016 and has recommended the extension of autonomous status upto the year 2021.

In October 2017, the College was re-accredited (3rd Cycle) by NAAC with 'A' grade.

THE MADURA COLLEGE BOARD

The College is administered by the Madura College Board, as also are the Sethupathi Higher Secondary School, Madura College Higher Secondary School and the Town Primary School. The Madura College Board elects a Board of Directors consisting of twelve members. From among the twelve Directors the President, the Vice President, the Secretary, the Joint Secretary and the Treasurer are elected.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

Extracts from the Madras Educational Rules :- (Chapter VII Disciplinary Regulations)

1. Students of all Schools and Colleges should abstain from active participation in party or communal politics.
2. Headmasters, Principals or other constituted school, college, hostel authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the conduct outside the school college or hostel precincts of students on the roll, so far as such rules seem necessary to

maintain the credit, usefulness and reputation of the School, College or hostel.

N.B. In the case of college such disciplinary regulation as may be issued by the respective universities to which they are affiliated and as are not inconsistent with the regulations in this chapter, will also apply.

Headmasters, Principals or other constituted school, college or hostel authorities shall have full power to inflict punishments in the interest of the students or the institution concerned.

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE

Regular attendance not only fetches you high score of marks but also an enriching experience with your classmates and teachers. Therefore, all the students must attend classes regularly. If there are some important and compelling reasons such as family celebrations, ill-health etc., students can avail leave after obtaining permission from the Vice Principal.

1. For every hour, the attendance of students is marked in the attendance register by the individual course teacher and be maintained in the office of the principal.
2. Attendance of the students will be periodically displayed in the notice board.
3. It should be remembered that 75% attendance is a pre-requisite to write all the papers in the Semester Exams and to avail Scholarships of any kind. No exemption will be granted in this regard.
4. Students who have physical attendance including O.D of less than 75% and above 65% due to illness

will be permitted to write examination after paying the fine decided by the attendance committee.

5. The maximum O.D. claim for a student in a semester is as follows:

Physical Education: Zonal level = 10 days
University and State level participation = 16 days
NSS/ NCC/ Co-curricular activities = 10 days

OTHER DUTY ATTENDANCE

6. Prior permission is required from Vice-Principal to avail On Duty leave.
7. Students who take part in Co-curricular and extra-curricular activities should contact the respective authorities (e.g.HODs, Co-ordinators of various clubs, Physical Director, NCC Officers, NSS programme officers) who in turn recommend OD to Vice Principal immediately.

LEAVE

8. Students have to apply for leave only in the format printed in the Student- Handbook.
9. The leave must be sanctioned by the Vice Principal.
10. If leave is availed on illness for more than three days, application must be accompanied by a medical certificate and submitted within three days of illness.
11. Leave letters, submitted after 3 days from the date of availing leave, will not be accepted.

GUIDELINES TO STUDENTS

The Madura College is dedicated to learning and updating of knowledge along with the inculcation of ethical values.

The following are strictly forbidden:

1. Ragging of any kind and any magnitude inside / outside the college campus.
2. Abuse of cellular phones within the campus like taking photos/ videos anywhere in the campus without explicit permission of the Vice Principal / HODs / Coordinator Discipline Cell. Mobile Phones, computers and Laptops are to be used only for academic purposes.
3. Use of cellular phones inside Classrooms / Labs / Library / corridors.
4. Any kind of disturbing behaviour in the campus.
5. Smoking / use of drugs, alcohol or peddling drugs in the campus are punishable and students who are indulging in such behaviour are liable for dismissal from the college.
6. Riding the two wheeler fast or use of vehicles with defective silencers or parking the vehicles outside the parking area in the campus.
7. Tampering with the contents or misuse of the college identity cards, library tokens etc.,
8. Any kind of misconduct / misbehaviour inside / outside the campus (in public places, buses, trains, etc.) or blocking the traffic, unruly behaviour in classrooms or any kind of annoyance to the public.
9. Malpractices such as cheating, copying in tests and exams, giving false declarations, spreading rumours / unfounded accusations / writing / printing / distributing / displaying unauthorised notices of any kind / SMS, cyber space etc., in the campus or anywhere else.

10. Inviting / meeting strangers or unauthorised person(s) inside the campus without written permission from the Principal.
11. Causing damage to college / public property.
12. Misusing of Instruments / Computers and Electric and Electronic devices in the Campus.
13. Standing in parking places and chatting during class hours.
14. Canvassing and organising students for any programme inside and outside the college without prior permission.
15. Posting of unpleasant / unacceptable / damaging statements / views about the college or staff in social media websites.

GENERAL GUIDELINES TO STUDENTS

16. Students are advised to wear their ID cards while they are at college every day.
17. The college expects all students to attend the regular Assembly programmes as well as special functions organized in the campus
18. The college expects each student to be responsible for maintaining tidy and clean campus. Any damage to the property of the college is a serious offence.
19. The college expects each student to be responsible for the safety of all personal property including money, bags, mobile and other costly materials. Students should not loiter on the campus during class hours.

20. During college holidays, students can come to college, only after getting prior written permission from their departments. Students should not entertain their friends from other colleges inside the campus.
21. In case of doubt regarding the interpretation of the rules and regulations of the college and on matters not covered by the above, the college authorities should be consulted for clarification and guidance.
22. During the unexpected absence of any teacher, students concerned should spend the time in the Departmental or General Library with the permission of HOD.
23. Students must conserve electric energy and water.

DRESS CODE

Dress code is not about what is convenient to wear as boys and girls but to wear simple and modest formal dress as students of the Madura College.

TWO WHEELER / FOUR WHEELER REGULATIONS

Four wheeler parking is not available for students. Two wheelers of students may be parked at the allotted space. Every student who comes to college by two wheeler is expected to wear HELMET.

FEE REGULATIONS

1. The academic year for the purpose of fees shall be divided into two semesters. The first semester starts from June and continues till November and the second semester commences in November and ends in April.

2. Every student shall pay the whole fees for each semester as long as his/her name is on the rolls of the college.
3. The students who do not pay the prescribed fees on or before the last date are liable to be removed from the rolls.
4. The Semester / Exam fees should be paid on the date indicated in the College Handbook.
5. If a student leaves the college during the middle of semester, he /she shall have no right to claim remission of any portion of the semester fees.
6. Students who do not pay the fees on or before the last date shall pay a fine levied and displayed in the notice board
7. Students who have paid both semester and exam fees alone will be permitted to write semester examinations

CURRICULUM – EVALUATION

Evaluation is based on Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) with a weightage of 25% and End semester examination with a weightage of 75% as stipulated by Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education norms

- 1) CIA includes two centralized tests and other components such as quiz, seminar, assignment, attendance etc.,
- 2) Both the tests are compulsory and the average of the two tests will be taken for the test component of CIA.

- 3) Those students who could not write the scheduled first & second CIA tests on genuine reasons shall contact the HODs concerned and request for re-tests.
- 4) There is no Pass minimum in CIA, however in the aggregate (External + CIA) the Pass minimum for UG and PG are 40% and 50% respectively

CONTINUOUS INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (CIA):

Theory Papers:

Components of Continuous Internal assessment (CIA) are as follows:

- 1) Two tests are averaged and scaled down to 15 marks.
- 2) Assignment / Seminar / Quiz, etc., for 5 marks.
- 3) Attendance for a maximum of 5 marks.

EXTERNAL SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS :

External examination will be conducted at the end of each semester for a maximum of 75 marks.

EVALUATION :

1. Double valuation is followed for UG, PG and M.Phil.
2. If the variation between the marks awarded by the two examiners differs by more than 15%, the paper will be automatically sent for THIRD valuation. Of the three marks, two nearest marks are averaged and

awarded to the students. If all the three marks are equally spaced, the best two marks are averaged and awarded to the students.

3. If the difference between the marks awarded by the two examiners is 15% or less, the two marks are **AVERAGED** and awarded to the student.

REVALUATION :

1. Students can apply for revaluation after the declaration of the end semester examination results. For revaluation, single external valuation will be done. The higher of (i) the mark obtained in End-semester result and (ii) mark obtained in revaluation would be awarded to the student.

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS:

1. Students with any number of outstanding arrears in the final semester of their respective courses and /or only one outstanding arrear in the rest of the semesters put together after the declaration of the final semester results can appear for the supplementary examinations of the corresponding year. In the supplementary examinations, the mark awarded by the single external examiner is awarded to the students.

REPEAT THE SEMESTER

1. Repeat of a semester can be permitted only when the student has not been issued Transfer Certificate and within three years from the date of completion of the course.
2. The student will repeat the appropriate semester on the courses offered during the time of repeat. If the

syllabus regulation has changed, the student will appear only in the current papers in vogue at the time of repeat.

3. For students repeating a single course/paper which has been scrapped or modified, the student will repeat the course only on the paper which is in vogue at the time of repeating the course. The chairman of the Board of studies will offer an equivalence on which the student will be tested.
4. A student will have the opportunity to write the course (paper) in vogue during his study for a maximum of 3 years only after the completion of the course period. On expiry of three years, the student will have to opt for an equivalence, as decided by the Head of Department from the syllabus which is in vogue.

If the candidate, owing to genuine reasons, could not appear before the enquiry committee and presents a letter before the date of relevant enquiry explaining his inability to appear before the enquiry committee and confessing the alleged act of malpractice, then it will be taken as CONFESSIO AT THE ENQUIRY, in the case of being absent for the relevant enquiry without such a letter it will be taken as NO CONFESSIO AT THE ENQUIRY.

In the case of any change in regulations in the courses concerned while joining the college / writing the examinations after the period of punishment, the incumbent has to follow the regulations current at the time of expiry of the punishment – period.

LIBRARY

1. The Library will be kept open on all working days from 9.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. On Sundays and other public holidays, the library will remain closed.
2. All the students and the staff of the College are members of the Library.

3. The Library consists of four sections : (a) Reference (b) Lending (c) Reading Room and (d) Department Libraries
4. Students should present their identity card with photograph while borrowing book from the Library.
5. When a student returns his books, he must present ID card.
6. Books should be returned on the due date. A student failing to do so will be fined one rupee for each day the book is delayed.
7. When a particular volume of a set of books is lost, the student may be called upon to replace the whole set.
8. On return, every book will be examined and if any book is found to be marked or soiled or damaged, the matter will be reported to the Principal for disciplinary action.

DIGITAL SECTION:

- Computers kept must be handled carefully.
- Usage of pendrives are prohibited.
- Assistance for the use of computers will be provided, if required
- Strict silence and decorum should be observed in the Library.

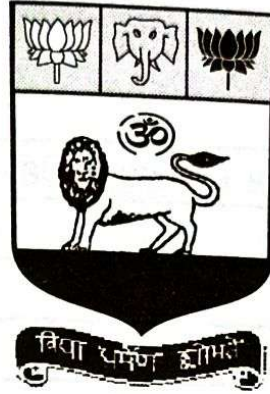
